
Key	Function	Description

$\rightarrow$	Forward	The next page in your browser history
G	Reload	Reload current page
7 4	Full screen	Open page in full-screen mode
	Display apps	Display open apps
<b>\Oldot</b>	Brightness down	Lower brightness
$\Diamond$	Brightness up	Increase brightness
1	Mute	Microphone off and on
<b>◆</b> >	Volume down	Turn sound down
<b>◆</b>	Volume up	Turn sound up

### **Touchpad**

The touchpad helps you move your pointer on the computer screen using touch gestures, so you don't have to use a mouse.

Visual	Function	Description
	Touchpad	The touchpad is the large square located under the keys. It responds to touch to move your pointer on your screen.
	Touch	Use one or two fingers to move your pointer by using the touchpad.
	Тар	Use the tap or double-tap gesture to select or open an item on the screen.
	Scrolling	Place two fingers slightly apart on the touchpad, and then drag them up and down to scroll vertically or left and right to move horizontally.

### **Battery**



Check to see if your computer is charging indicated by a light on the right side of your computer (more info below).

Keep the AC adapter connected until the light turns white when it is fully charged.

Visual	Status	Description
	White	The AC adapter is connected, and the battery is fully charged
	Amber	The AC adapter is connected, and the battery is charging
	Off	The computer is not charging

Press the power button to turn your computer on. If it does not turn on, you may need to charge the battery.
